LG Nelson McClinchey introduced **PLG David MacLennan** as our guest speaker, who addressed the new “Two on Two” membership program by outlining an approach used based on his experience with the Stratford Club.

PLG David MacLennan’s presentation was a three-step process.

Step #1- Overview:

- He offered examples of how two members can be paired to approach two known prospects, possibly known to one of the two members. As we get these new members, there would be a synergy toward the existing members which would likely result in new ideas for our club.
- He outlined how we should look for skills that we need that our current members don’t have by brainstorming with our members to see if collectively we can put prospective names to those skills in which we are lacking. He also indicated a number of other sources where we may find these skills and related prospective members.

Step #2 - Workshop

- A handout was distributed to all members showing various Skill Types that we may need with a text area for a Prospect's Name or Company and the name of a Kiwanis Member if known.
- The members at each table discussed and recorded the results for about 10 minutes while PLG David circulated around the room listening in and asking questions and suggesting options.

Step #3 -Summarize

- PLG David polled each table asking how many new names or organizations we had found.
- We came up with 19 people and 16 organizations to look to for perspective new members.
- This information was collected by Joanne **Murry** of the Membership Committee for further use in finding new members.
