Funmasters, Faye Prince and Paul Simon did a delightful rendition of the surprising answers, lawyers sometimes receive when crossexamining witnesses.




Maureen Henry Introduced the Guest Speakers: Tara Buchanan and Machina Veri and briefly outlined the function and process of Belonging Brant.
