President Nancy called on Nelson McClinchey to set the objective for today's meeting about the Membership Committee 2024-2025 Action Plan development.


- Nelson explained that todays meeting objective was to collect ideas and suggestions from the members in order to create an effective plan designed to acquire and retain members, by setting goals, creating actions to achieve those goals and creating metrics for the plan's success.
- Nelson used a slide presentation to supply background information for consideration during our discussion.

- Finally Nelson asked, "What can we do as a team to achieve our goal?


Nelson asked Joanne Murray to come to the podium.

- That monthly Membership Reports made to the Board regarding actions and progress of the Membership Committee's plan
