Highlights of the Thursday, 04 September, 2025 Weekly Meeting


President Nancy, welcomed all members, to a special meeting with the Topic: "Being a Board Member or Committee Chair".




President Nancy thanked LG Randy and called on our speakers for today to address our topic.
