

RE: Ducky Derby 2022

Dear Club President and/or Club Secretary,

It is time again for the Ducky Derby! Enclosed with this letter you will find two Ducky Derby tickets per member. Sell tickets at your meetings, to friends, neighbors, co-workers, at club functions, or at church functions, just to share a few examples. Alternately, use the information sheet provided that explains how people can purchase tickets on-line on the foundation web page under the Ducky Derby tab.

The drawing will take place at the conclusion of the House of Delegates on Saturday, August 20, 2022, at District Convention, Baltimore, MD. You do not need to be present to win – just complete the ticket legibly.

This is the largest fundraiser for the Capital District Kiwanis Foundation (CDKF) and all proceeds help support nine pediatric trauma centers supported by the Foundation. The goal this year is to raise a minimum of \$14,000.

Appoint a "Ducky Derby Sales Chair" to give sales pitches at your meetings using this letter and the provided flier and information sheet.

Start selling the tickets now and continue selling until DCON in August, especially to members who haven't made the commitment previously. Please make every effort to sell all your tickets. If you need additional tickets, please use the online purchase option at the Foudation web site. The tickets sale price is the same as last year: \$5.00 each or 3 for \$10.00.

Please be forceful in your sale efforts so your members will understand how important it is to support the Foundation's efforts in assisting pediatric trauma centers. You will be helping children in need of critical treatment. 100% of the proceeds raised through Ducky Derby ticket sales are donated to the centers. Remember, this is a community service project and tickets may and should be sold to the public.

Prizes: Cash prizes of \$750, \$500, \$250, and various gift cards. Last year there were 13 \$50 gift cards to various restaurants and retail stores.
