1:30 pm – 2:20 pm

1. "Guide to the How-Tos and What-Fors of New and Used Clubs" – Melanie Bozak and Lonnie Johnson - St.

Helens "C" room. This session will have a hands-on approach that will:

- 1. Apply to opening new clubs AND growing your club.
- 2. Help you make telephone appointments with prospective new members, city and county leadership, and school administration.
- 3. Help you conduct in-person meetings with the contacts established through telephone appointments, roleplay a meeting, learn to listen for clues, when to STOP talking about Kiwanis to concentrate on the other person, and how to tell your Kiwanis moment efficiently, and
- 4. Show you how to ask for referrals, which is a key component of growing your list of potential members.

2. "Risk Management and Youth Protection" - Bill Glenn – St. Helens "D" room.

"What is Risk? How can your Kiwanis Club lessen its Risks? What is Youth Protection? How does that affect your Kiwanis interaction with kids? Background checks – who needs them? How do you get them? How do Risk Management and Youth Protection work together? Answers for all these questions and more."

3. "PNW Membership Team – Growth and Support" – Melanie Bozak and Lonnie Johnson –

St. Helens "C" room. This is a hands-on, interactive session to help you grow your club membership. You'll learn (and do some work) recruiting members and getting your members involved in strengthening the club. Also, we'll cover finding community contacts, analyzing your projects, and more. You will create a plan to hit the ground running when you get home.

4. "Keep Your Club Safe in Cyberspace" – Makenzie Carroll – Kiwanis Int'l. – St Helens "D" room. Join the "Keep Your Club Safe in Cyberspace" session to learn about combating cyber threats. Understand emotional hijacking, recognize phishing, smishing, vishing, and scams, and learn to identify red flags in suspicious communications. Gain insights on effective response strategies and tools to safeguard your club and personal information in the digital world. Protect yourself and your club online.

- 5. "Lt. Governors Next Step of the Hero's Journey" (NOTE: this session is from <u>3:30pm 5:20pm</u>) Don Gibbard and Bigfoot Brigade Mt. Adams room. This session is intended for current Lt. This will be a very interactive session to continue the training of Lt. Governors by focusing on how the first third of the year has gone, helping the Lt.
