The “Bigfoot Brigade” is the name of the Pacific Northwest Kiwanis past Lt. Governors association. We were formed to provide support to the PNW District in a variety of ways. Our main functions are:

- Work with the current Lt. Governors to help support their divisions and create a past Lt. Governors group for each division.
- Coordinate with the District to provide Lt. Governor training.
- Raise funds to offset the cost of the District’s Lt. Governor training.
- Raise funds to support district personnel in their quest for International offices.

The Bigfoot Brigade governance structure is as follows:

- Chairman
- Vice Chair
- Secretary / Treasurer
- Past Chair
- Regional Directors (5 each)
- Lt. Governor class president (current year / non-voting)

The PNW District is divided into five regions. There are 5 to 8 divisions in each region. The regional directors reach out to each Lt. Governor in their region to offer the support of the Bigfoot Brigade in four main areas:

- Creating an active past Lt. Governors group in each division.
- Help establish division council meetings in each division.
- Help with Lt. Governor succession planning.
- Help identify which clubs in division that need help.

The regional directors report the status of each region twice a year, at the Mid-Winter Conference and DCON.

The only requirement to become a member of the Bigfoot Brigade is to be a past Lt. Governor and pay the one time membership fee of \$100. Just click on the link above.
