RANDOLPH KIWANIS 50th Annual Freedom Parade

Saturday, July 11, 2026

**Lineup Starts at 8:30am - Need to be in Your Spot by 9:30am
Kickoff is 10:00am**

Join us for the Randolph Kiwanis Freedom Parade on **Saturday, July 11, 2026**. The Freedom Parade celebrates the Freedom we cherish as Americans and honors the men and women in uniform who have served, and now are serving, our great nation. The Freedom Parade is sponsored by the all-volunteer, not-for-profit Randolph Kiwanis Club in partnership with Randolph Township.

Time: Lineup begins at 8:30am. You need to be in your lineup position by 9:30am. Kickoff of Freedom Parade is 10:00am. All entries done by Noon.

Where: The Freedom Parade will kick off at the Haridham Temple located at the corner of Dover Chester Road and Quaker Church Road (For GPS purposes, 443 Quaker Church Road, Randolph, NJ 07869). Entries will be staged in the Fernbrook area of Randolph.

Parade Route: The Freedom Parade proceeds down Quaker Church Road, turns right on Center Grove Road, crosses Route 10 and ends at County College of Morris (CCM). The route is about 1.4 miles long.

Restrooms: Located at the Haridham Temple - 443 Quaker Church Road. Please remove your shoes before entering the Temple - slippers will be provided for your use. Also, Porta Johns will be at the top of the driveway of the YMCA across the street.

Optional Shuttle Service for Drivers of Groups to the Lineup Area: Since there is no parking on Freedom Parade Day in the lineup area, beginning at 8:00am we will run an optional shuttle service. The optional shuttles are **for drivers of groups who already have dropped off the other members of their group at their lineup positions (we do not have enough shuttles to transport entire groups or bands).**

Two shuttles will run continuously from Parking Lot #1 at the County College of Morris (“CCM”) where the Freedom Parade ends to the corner of Dover Chester Road and Quaker Church Road where the Freedom Parade kicks off. **The last shuttle will leave CCM at 9:30 am.**

Drivers of groups may drop off participants at their lineup positions, drive to Parking Lot #1 at CCM to park and then return to their lineup positions using the shuttle service. When the Freedom Parade ends at CCM, everyone can walk to their cars in the CCM parking lot.

Deadline for Receipt of Entry Form is Thursday, July 2, 2026: email this short form for receipt by the deadline to Volunteer Parade Director Geoffrey (“Geoff”) Price, geoffprice@optonline.net. You will be notified via email of your staging area and other logistical info a couple days prior to the Freedom Parade so you can network it to your group. Questions?
