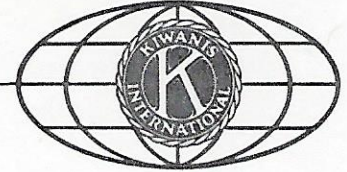

Roy W. Davis, Chicago, Illinois, is president of Kiwanis International, a community service organization of 280,000 members and 6500 clubs throughout the United States, Canada, and forty five other countries.

Prior to being elected president in June 1974, at the organization's 59th annual convention in Denver, Davis served one year terms as president-elect (1973-74), vice-president (1972-73), treasurer (1971-72), and four years as an international trustee (1967-71). As president, he is chairman of the Kiwanis International Executive Committee and a trustee of the Kiwanis International Foundation.

Davis is a former lieutenant governor and governor of the Illinois-Eastern Iowa Kiwanis District, and past president of the Kiwanis Club of Chicago. He has been a member of the Kiwanis International Committee on Spiritual Aims and the Special International Committee on Organization Study. He is a former president of the Kiwanis International Foundation and has been a member and chairman of several district committees during his twenty-six years of Kiwanis service.

Davis, a vice-president of Continental Illinois National Bank And Trust Company, handles the financial needs of the insurance industry. He began his banking career with Continental in 1931 and was named vice president in 1961.

He holds memberships in the American Institute of Banking and the Chicago Association of Commerce and Industry. Davis is also a member of the Newcomen Society, the American Legion, the Christian Business Men's Committee and the South Suburban Family Counseling Service.

Currently a member of the Board of Counselors of Oxford College of Emory University, Atlanta, Georgia, Davis is also a trustee and past treasurer of the Bethany Brethren-Garfield Park Community Hospital of Chicago. He is a past trustee of the Bethany Theological Seminary and the Chicago Hospital Council. He is a lay minister of the St. Paul Community Church in Homewood, Illinois.

Davis and his wife, Evelyn, have a son and a daughter, both married. They have three grandchildren.
