DONALD E. WILLIAMS PRESIDENT, KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL 1935 - 1936

Donald E. Williams of 19 Parkview Drive, Berea, Ohio was chosen as President of Kiwanis international at the Annual Convention of Kiwanis International in Toronto, Canada, July 3, 1985. He took over the reins of office on October 1, 1985, assuming leadership of a worldwide association of 8,200 clubs with over 315,000 members. Williams term of office will be for one year, following his contributions to the organization by serving as a Trustee for four years, as a Vice President, Treasurer, and President Elect.

Williams, a retired utility executive, has served on the Kiwanis International governing board since 1978 in addition to being a 39-year member and past president of the Kiwanis Club of Berea.

Outside his Kiwanis involvement, Don has been an active leader in community affairs. He is a past chairman of the Berea United Appeal and the Southwest YMCA Board, as well as a past president of the Southwest General Hospital Board of Trustees and Berea Little Theater. He also served as a Trustee of Blue Cross of Northeast Ohio and the Northeast Ohio Medical Program. He was honored with the Outstanding Trustee Award by the Greater Cleveland Hospital Association in 1978.

Don and Sally Williams have one daughter and one grandson.

On the occasion of the 71st Birthday Celebration of Kiwanis, the Michigan District wishes to acknowledge Don for his long and distinguished service to Kiwanis.
