It is pleasure and distinct honor for the Kiwanis Club of Ann Arbor to recognize Forney W. Clement Pst Sec'y-Treasurer of the Michigan District Kiwanis International as a Distinguised Kiwanian.

Forney was a member and Past Vice President and Sec'y. of this Club. He served from 1930 to 1942 as District Sec'y-Treas and Editor of The Michigan Builder. All of this he did from his office in Ann Arbor. He and our former member Ashley H. Clague along with others combined thier efforts on the project in the Childrens Ward in The University of Michigan Hospital. This Project had been originally begun by the Club in 1922. It was designated a District Program at the Convention in Traverse City 1934.

In 1944, two years after his passing the project was named The Forney W. Clement Memorial Project. In 1961 and subsiquent years it was expanded as follows:

(Forney W. Clement)
Mary Free Bed Hospital and Rehabilitation
Complex. (Ben Dean Project)
Northern Michigan Hospital (Herman H Meyer)
Charles W. Schull Coloring Book Project.

Today the Foundation is called Kiwanis of Michigan Foundation and supported by all clubs in The District.

Forney W. Clement in his efforts on behalf of the hospitalized children and youth, will long be remembered as a caring Kiwanian and friend of children. Because of him and many others the good work goes on in the Institutions served. We honor Past Dist-Sec'y-Treas. Forney W. Clement as a dedicated Distinguished Kiwanian in The Foundation.
