Glen served in the U. S. Army in World War 1 and on the S. A. R. (Sons of American Revolution) State Board of Governors. He served on the Board of Trustees at the Owosso Congregational Church and on the Board of Directors of the Owosso Federal Savings and Loan Association. At one time he was Vice President of the bank in Rosebush, MI.

While serving on the Owosso Improvement Association he was selected by Gordon Nutson, President of the Chamber of Commerce, to be Chairman of the Retail Merchants Committee.

In the Asphalt roofing, thence building materials business, it kept him on the road a lot. However, he found time to be a Kiwanian four different times, the first being in the 1920's in Owosso at the age of 25. Hr served as the Club Secretary and was given an Honorary Membership for suggesting, promoting and carring it through to a very profitable club fund raiser which was continued for many years. He joined the club again in the 1940's. His business was transferred to Grand Rapids and he joined the Downtown Club in 1947 and was an active member through 1953.

During the early years of residency in Grand Rapids he served as Chairman of the Civic Affairs Committee with other sub committee's under it such as fire prevention and others.

Glen an active charter member of the National Wholesales building Materials Association, was written up in the Building Supply News Magazine for his outstanding ethical operations.

He joined the Golden K. Kiwanis Club of Grand Rapids on August 16, 1983 and is a very active and highly respected member.

Glen is a member of the East Congregational Cgurch where he has held resonsible offices and served on various committees.

He is a fine gentleman, and a Kiwanian of which we are all very proud. His achievements and devotion certainly deserves our recognition and thanks.
