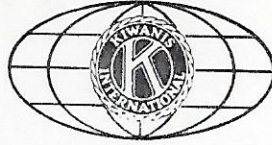

A CHARTER MEMBER OF THE LAKEVIEW (BATTLE CREEK) KIWANIS CLUB, HE WAS SECRETARY IN 1947 AND 1948; PRESIDENT IN 1949; AND LT. GOVERNOR, DIVISION EIGHT, MICHIGAN DISTRICT KIWANIS, INTERNATIONAL IN 1952. HE SERVED AS A BOARD MEMBER OF THE FORNEY W. CLEMENT FOUNDATION, 1953 - 1958, AND WAS VICE PRESIDENT IN 1959.

BORN IN WARSAW, INDIANA, HE CAME TO BATTLE CREEK IN 1962. IN HIS BUSINESS CAREER, SPANNING 39 YEARS WITH THE POST DIVISION OF GENERAL FOODS CORPORATION, HE STARTED AS A SAMPLE BOY AND ROSE TO SUPERINTENDENT OF BRANCH LABORATORIES.

ROGER WAS ACTIVE IN COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, SERVING MANY AGENCIES IN LEADERSHIP CAPACITIES, AND PERHAPS MOST NOTABLY AS PRESIDENT OF THE CALHOUN COUNTY SOCIETY OF CRIPPLED CHILDREN AND ADULTS.
