Charles F. (Charley) Fox joined Kiwanis in 1946 and has served as President (twice) of Central Detroit, Lieutenant Governor of Division One in 1965, and District Secretary 1968-73. Charley is currently Secretary of the New Center, Detroit club and is Kiwanis International Accredited Representative for Division One. He served on the Board of Trustees of the Kiwanis of Michigan Foundation in the sixties and again in the eighties.

While serving as District Secretary, Charley spearheaded the establishment of the District Sponsored Youth Fund, and set up the double-entry accounting system for District financial records.

Charley was born in Detroit in 1918, attended Northern High School, and graduated from Wayne University in 1940 with a B.A. degree in music. In recent years, he helped to establish a Key Club at Northern and a Circle K club at Wayne State.

Charley's business pursuits have included building management, commercial real estate, and manufacturers representative. He is past Moderator of North Congregational Church where he joined the chancel choir in 1936 and still sings in the bass section, doing occasional solo and quartet work. Charley is also a member of the Board of the Christian Communication Council. Hobbies include acting, bowling and duplicate bridge.
