ANDREW J. PARKER TRUSTEE DIVISION 10 1986-1988

Andrew joined the Brighton Club in November of Fifty Six and was given the Chairmanship of the Boys and Girls Committee a job he took to heart after a visit to the U of M Hospital in Ann Arbor.

The eleventh floor of old Main housed the Polio ward and was crowded with iron lungs, to the extent that many were parked in the corridors with patients in them.

Andrew served as President of the Brighton Club in 1961 and again in 1971.

In 1987-88 year he was honored by the Brighton Club for Twenty years of service on the Childrens Committee.

In August of 1992 he was awarded the Distinguished Kiwanian Award by the Kiwanis of Michigan Foundation.

The International and the Michigan District of Kiwanis awarded the Legion of Honor to Andrew in November of 1996 for Forty years of service as a Kiwanian.

As a Trustee for division 10 he raised the giving in division 10 to over 100% for many years, serving from 1986 to 1998, during his term as President the by-laws on restricting investments to bonds only were changed to allow stock funds to be used.
