He served as Governor of the Indiana District in 1978-79. A George T. Hixson Fellow, Tablet of Honor, and Life Fellow of the Kiwanis International Foundation, Bill holds Life Member status in Kiwanis International. He served as trustee of the Kiwanis International Foundation in 1986-87.
