Frank Graduated from Muskegon High School in 1965. He received his Bachelors Degree in 1969 and his Masters Degree in 1973, both from Western Michigan University.


Frank was a Certified Public Accountant and owned his own accounting firm.


Frank was married on June 15, 1974, to his wife Martha, and they had two children, a son, John and a daughter, Jennifer.
