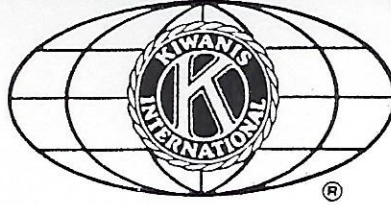




Robert Evans
