Stanley E. Schneider, Crestline, Ohio automotive retail and investment executive, was confirmed as president of Kiwanis International at the organization's 61st annual convention in San Diego in June, 1976.

Prior to his election to the post of president, Schneider served one year as president-elect, one year as treasurer, one year as vice-president of Kiwanis International and three years as a trustee. He has been president of the Kiwanis Club of Crestline, lieutenant governor and governor of the Ohio Kiwanis District, member and chairman of several district committees, and chairman of the Kiwanis International Committees on Inter-Club Relations and Fellowship, and Membership Development. He has also been a member of the International Committee on Boys and Girls Work. He is a member of the Kiwanis International Foundation's Board.

Currently, Schneider is serving as chairman of the Executive Committee of Kiwanis International. He has been a Kiwanian for 19 years.

Schneider has been appointed by the governor of the State of Ohio to serve as a member of the state's Advisory Committee for Operation Crime Alert.

He has served two terms as a member of the City Council and has been a member of the Elections Board and the Volunteer Fire Department. He is a member of the Chamber of Commerce. He also has been active with the area council of the Boy Scouts. Schneider was one of the principal organizers of the local United Fund, and was chairman of the Crestline School Bond Issue Campaign. He is a past trustee and chairman of the Commission on Stewardship and Finance for the First United Methodist Church of Crestline.

He is a member of the National Automobile Dealers Association, the National Guard Officers Association, the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Marine Corp League, and the Association of the United States Army.
