

Ralph S. Hamilton joined the Kiwanis Club of Charlevoix on January 6, 1948. He was secretary of the Club for fifteen years and President in 1957. He served as Lieutenant Governor of Division 15 (now 20) in 1960.

He was a Trustee of the Forney W. Clement Memorial Foundation for nine years and President of the Foundation 1976-1977. Also, he is Past District Chairman of Vocational Guidance-Support of Churches.

Through the years, he has attended nine Kiwanis International Conventions and twenty-five Michigan District Conventions. He has had perfect attendance for twenty-nine years and is a thirty-year Legion of Honor Member.

His civic duties include serving as Alderman of the City of Charlevoix for eight years; Deputy County Clerk of Charlevoix County for twenty-four years; Public Administrator for six years; reactivated the Charlevoix Area Historical Society and was its first President; former Scoutmaster-Cub Master of the Boy Scouts of America; Past President of the Northern Michigan Independent Accountants Association; Past President of the Northern Michigan Clerks and Secretaries Association; member of the City of Charlevoix Housing Commission; oldest member and organizer of the Charlevoix Federal Credit Union; Dedicatory Chairman of the Veterans Memorial Park-Veterans Bridge.

He has been married to Margit Agnes Cherney for fifty-one years (married August 16, 1926); they have three sons and seven grand-children. He has been a self-employed public accountant for forty-four years.
