Carl F. Beckwith Jr. originally joined the Detroit #1 Kiwanis Club in August of 1950. He held various committee posts in the club emphasizing his interest in youth-promotional activities. He became a member of the Dearborn Kiwanis Club in February of 1966 and served that club in various capacities including Club President, an office which he held at the time of his death on April 24, 1974. Carl was a dedicated Kiwanian and participated fully in the charitable projects undertaken by his clubs. He was particularly sensitive to projects dedicated to improving the youth of his community and concentrated on activities of the Boys and Girls Committee. He held a deep admiration for the Forney Clement Foundation and it was fitting that at the time of his untimely death, his club and other clubs in the fourth Michigan Division of Kiwanis made a memorial contribution to the foundation in Carl F. Beckwith's name.
