RAY HALL - KIWANIS ACTIVITIES

(A Synopsis of Over 56 Years as a Member of the Kiwanis Club of Owosso)

- 1921 Became a Kiwanian at age 30 as a Charter Member of the Kiwanis Club of Owosso (hereinafter referred to as K C of 0).
- 1925 Was instrumental in having K C of O provide a house for a widow and three children.
- 1926 President of the K C of O.
 - Club was active in many worthwhile community programs including work on Dorcas Home, Christmas parties for underprivileged children, dental care for the needy, and many similar activities.
- 1934 Worked on the University Hospital Children's program with Joseph Prance, Art Pierpont, and Gladwin Lewis.
- 1939 Lieutenant Governor of Division 4 with the following Clubs:

Clubs were active in Kiwanis Forest Program in Oscoda County.

- 1953 Chairman of District Underprivileged Children Committee which became the Forney W. Clement Project.
- 1971 Observed his 50th year anniversary in Kiwanis.
- 1974 Attended the Kiwanis International Convention at Denver.
- 1977 Continues in his 56th year as a Kiwanian to attend meetings weekly.
