## THOMAS P. OLIVER

Tom Oliver was inducted as a member of the Kiwanis Club of Hillsdale, Michigan in 1944 and for the past thirty-four years has had a perfect attendance record.

In 1949 Tom was made Chairman of the 25th Anniversary Committee of the Hillsdale Club. He was elected President of his club in 1952. In 1953 Tom was chosen Lt. Governor of the former Division 8, and also was made a member of the Michigan District "On to Seattle" committee. He was Michigan District Chairman of Kiwanis Education and Fellowship in 1956, and for fifteen years was a member of the Michigan District Committee on Achievement Reporting.

Since 1970, Tom has been especially active in the Kiwanis organization, serving in several responsible positions in the Michigan District. Beginning, in the years of 1970 and 1971, he was a member of the Kiwanis International Committee on Achievement Reporting. In 1971-72 Tom was Michigan District Chairman of Interclub Relations and Fellowship. He was Governor Elect of the Michigan District in 1972-73 and was elected Governor of the Michigan District in 1973-74. Tom served as Chairman of the Michigan District Committee on Finance and Fund Raising in 1974-75 and was Chairman of the Council of Past Governors of the Michigan District in 1975-76.

He was graduated from Hillsdale College in 1939 and was employed by the Michigan Blue Cross-Blue Shield from 1945 until his recent retirement. This assignment took him throughout Michigan as a management contact representative. He is well known among the bankers of Michigan as well as the officials of many of the municipalities of Michigan.

Tom and his wife, Harriett, were married in 1936 and have two sons and four grandchildren. They are active members of the First United Presbyterian Church in Hillsdale where Tom is an Elder and has worked on many committee assignments.

In addition to Kiwanis, Tom has served on the Hillsdale Community Chest, Red Cross, Boy Scouts, and other community fund-raising efforts.
