PRESIDENT, KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL

Hilmar L. "Bill" Solberg, advertising manager for the Farm Equipment Division of Koehring Company, Appleton, Wisconsin, and member of the Kiwanis Club of Appleton, was elected president of Kiwanis International on June 18, 1978 during the organization's 63rd annual convention. He is currently on leave of absence.

As president, Solberg is a member of the Kiwanis International Board of Trustees, its 18-member governing body and spokesman for some 295,000 Kiwanians in more than 7,000 clubs world-wide.

Prior to his election to the post of president, Solberg served one year as president-elect, one year as treasurer, one year as vice-president, and two two-year terms as a trustee of Kiwanis International. He has also been president of the Kiwanis Club of Appleton, lieutenant governor and governor of the Wisconsin-Upper Michigan Kiwanis District, and a member and chairman of a number of district committees. He holds Life Member Status in Kiwanis International and is a Life Fellow of the Kiwanis International Foundation. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Kiwanis International Foundation.

Currently he is chairman of the Board's Executive Committee. He has been a Kiwanian for 18 years.
