The Kiwanis Club of Tecumseh is proud to honor Edwin F. Walters. As a member of the Club since 1969 with perfect attendance, Ed has served on the Board of Directors for 7 years, Past Chairman of Membership Development for 3 years, Past Chairman of Public Relations for 6 years when he earned a District Award for 1975-76, and District and International Convention Delegate. Ed was the first club President in Division Eight to receive the Distinguished President's Award in the in jal year of it's commencement in 1972-73, and served as Division Eight's Lt. Governor for 1978-79.

Ed's community involvement extends beyond Kiwanis where in the Tecumseh United Methodist Church he has served on several boards and committees, as a member of the choir, and Past President of United Methodist Men for 1974 and 1975. Also in the Lenape District of the Wolverine Council of Boy Scouts of America he has been the Institutional Representative and/or Committeeman for three units for 8 years, member of the Lenape District Committee, Past Chairman of the Lenape District Finance Committee for 3 years, received an award for Sustaining Membership Enrollment Program Development for Lenape District in 1975, in 1978 was a recipient of a District Award of Merit, and the Wolverine Council has awarded their highest honor for volunteer services to Ed in 1979 – the coveted Silver Beaver Award.

As well as these, Ed has been a board member and officer of the Tuckabatchee Council, Camp Fire Girls of America, Inc. since 1976; has for the last 11 years served in various capacities of service for the Tecumseh Community Fund Foundation, Inc. and Lenawee County United Way; and was active in the community's Town Meeting '76 and Historic District. In 1973 he was named one of the Outstanding Young Men of America, and in 1978 received the Michigan Minuteman Citation of Honor.

Ed has been employed by Fisher Body Division of General Motors in Tecumseh for 14 years where he is the Employee Program Administrator. His employer has recognized Ed's unselfish endeavors by honoring him as a 1979 Gold Medalist in the GM Award for Excellence Program for community service.
