ANDREW M. BRYAN WAS BORN IN NEW JERSEY IN 1923. AFTER A 4 YEAR STINT IN THE U.S. NAVY, ANDY ATTENDED THE NEW YORK INSURANCE INSTITUTE. UPON GRADUATION, HE SOON FOUND HIS WAY TO MICHIGAN AS THE FIELD MANAGER FOR THE ROYAL INSURANCE COMPANY. HIS BUSINESS ACTIVITY BROUGHT HIM TO PORT HURON IN 1956 AND IN 1965 HE JOINED THE KIWANIS CLUB OF PORT HURON.

IN 1969 HE BECAME PRESIDENT OF HIS CLUB DURING THE CLUBS 50th ANNIVERSARY YEAR. THE YEAR 1972 FOUND ANDY AS THE LT. GOVERNOR OF DIVISION 3 AND IT WAS NO SURPRISE THAT HE EARNED THE TITLE "DISTINGUISHED" FOR HIS EFFORTS RESULTED IN THE FORMATION OF A NEW KIWANIS CLUB, A NEW KEY CLUB, AND A NEW CIRCLE K CLUB IN HIS DIVISION.

ANDY CONTINUED TO SERVE THE DIVISION AND THE DISTRICT AS ZONE CHAIRMAN

FOR TWO YEARS AND AS A DIVISION CHAIRMAN FOR INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS, THEN

FINANCE. HIS ELECTION AS GOVERNOR-ELECT AND THEN AS GOVERNOR IN 1978-79
