Mark A. Smith, Jr., a member of the Kiwanis Club of North DeKalb, Georgia, was elected to the presidency of Kiwanis International during the 64th Annual Convention in Toronto, Ontario on July 4, 1979. Mark is an Atlanta businessman, a BUILDER. His father, Mark A. Smith, also served as Kiwanis International President in 1940—1941, making them the first father and son presidential team in Kiwanis History.

Prior to becomming president of Kiwanis, Smith served one year as president-elect, one year as treasurer, one year as vice-president, and two two-year terms as trustee of Kiwanis International.

His other Kiwanis duties include service as president of his local Kiwanis club, governor of the Georgia Kiwanis District, and as a member and chairman of both district and Kiwanis International committees. He holds Life Membership Status in Kiwanis, and is a Life Fellow of the Kiwanis International Foundation. He is a 28 year veteran of Kiwanis.

Mark is active in a number of city, state and national organizations, highlighted by membership on the Board of Directors of the National Easter Seal Society; membership on the Board of Counselors, Oxford College, of Emory University; and of the Governor's Youth Opportunity Council. Locally he has served as president and director of the Atlanta Classic Foundation, as a member of the Chamber of Commerce, and as head of the Allocation Division of the Atlanta Community Chest. He is an Elder of his Presbyterian Church, a Mason, Shriner, and a Colonel in the United States Army Reserve.

Mark and his wife, Lurline, have a married son, a daughter, and a grandson.
