Merald T. Enstad, a member of the Kiwanis Club of Fergus Falls, Minnesota, was elected President of Kiwanis International as the highlight of the 65th annual convention of Kiwanis International in Anaheim, California.

Prior to his election as president, Enstad served one year as president-elect, one year as treasurer, one year as a vice president, and two two year terms as a trustee of Kiwanis International. He has been president of the Kiwanis Club of Fergus Falls, lieutenant governor and governor of the Minnesota-Dakotas Kiwanis District, and both member and chairman of a number of district committees. He has also served as chairman of the International Committees on Achievement, and Support of Churches in Their Spiritual Aims, and as a member of the International Committee on Circle K Clubs.

Merald is currently assigned to the Kiwanis International Board's Committee on Key Clubs where he serves as chairman, and to its Executive, Finance, and Personnel, and Convention Committees.

He is a Life Fellow of the Kiwanis International Foundation, and holds Life Membership Status in Kiwanis International. Enstad has been a Kiwanian for 31 years.

Active in professional, civic, and philanthropical work in addition to Kiwanis, Enstad is a past chairman of the Fergus Falls Park Board, past member of the city Planning Commission, and of the Mayors Advisory Committee. He is also a past director of the Fergus Falls Industrial Development Corporation. He is a past director of the Minnesota Association for Crippled Childrens and Adults, and currently serves as a member of the Advisory Council of Fergus Falls Community College.

Merald has been both a member and officer in state and national insurance and real estate associations. He has been president of the YMCA, Jaycees, Chamber of Commerce, PTA Council, and County Welfare Advisory Council. He is a past member of the Church Council and past leader-preacher in Area Stewardship of the Luthern Church. In 1977, he was named one of the " ten most influential men in Fergus Falls."
