Warren A. Bunge, born February 24, 1912, Oak Park, Illinois. Graduate of Oak Park-River Forrest High School, Oak Park, Illinois. Graduate of University of Illinois, 1933. Married Dorothy L. Long in Oak Park, Illinois on September 23, 1939. During World War II was drafted into the U.S. Navy. Served on the U.S.S. Compton-DD 705. Moved to Sturgis in 1946. In 1950 he became Office Manager of Freeman Manufacturing Co., in Sturgis. He was elected Treasurer of the Company.

In 1947, with Herschel Davis as his sponsorer, he joined the Kiwanis Club. During his years with Kiwanis he was the first General Chairman of Travelogue, he served on club chairmanships, as board member, secretary and as an officer in which he later became President in 1960. In 1968 he began serving in the office as treasurer, an office which he still holds. Has 27 years of perfect attendance.

He is a member of Holy Angels Catholic Church. Serves as Lector and Commentator, member of the choir, and chairman of the church's Finance Commission. Is a member of Klinger Lake County Club.

In recognition of Warren's years of outstanding and unselfish services to his club and community, he was designated by The Sturgis Kiwanis Club as a Distinguished Kiwanian and a contribution was made to the Kiwanis of Michigan Foundation, Inc., this being a perpetual recognition in his honor.
