

Born - August 14, 1914 in Kalamazoo, Michigan

Dick, who joined Kiwanis in November, 1946, has been a faithful and active member for 37 years, President 1952, member of the Board of Directors, Club Secretary 1953-57, Treasurer 1978 to 1980, serving on many committees and had a perfect attendance for 17 years.

At the District level, Dick was Lt. Governor representing the 5th Division in 1960. Member of the Board of Trustees of the Forney W. Clement Memorial Foundation, (now known as the Kiwanis of Michigan Foundation) from 1962 - 1979. Secretary of the Board from 1965 - 1969, President in 1969, Treasurer of the Foundation from 1972 - 1979.

A Life Member of the National Education Association, Dick was a respected educator and administrator in the Michigan education system from 1935 until his retirement in 1972.

He is a member of the First Congregational Church of Rochester, served as Moderator of the Congregation, member of the Board of Trustees, Board of Religious Council and many other committees and boards.

A memorial to one of Dick's achievements in Rochester is Cliffview, a senior citizen apartment complex. He served as co-chairman of survey committee to study housing needs for the elderly. He was the first President of the Board of Directors of the group, Rochester Retirement Non Profit Housing Corp. Dick was involved in the planning, obtaining financing and built the complex, and presently manages the operation as the Administrator.

Dick was the first citizen to receive the "Citizen of the Year" award presented by the Rochester Chamber of Commerce and Rochester Eccentric Newspaper.

Richard T. Huizenga, a dedicated Kiwanian, has given something special with his leadership and dedication to his community and for the best interests of its citizens.
