Paul was summoned up by his Uncle Sam, and after a tour of duty with the U.S. Navy, he returned to capture the hand-in-marriage of his Jr. High School sweetheart Gale. From that union has come two Kiwanian sons, Tim and Dan, and a daughter Dee. After 36 years of marriage, the family has expanded to include two daughters in law, a son in law, and ten grandchildren.
