

AUBREY E. IRBY PRESIDENT, KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL 1983 - 1984

Aubrey E. Irby, Tyler, Texas, an investment consultant and member of the Kiwanis Club of Tyler, was elected President of Kiwanis International as a climax to the 68th annual convention of Kiwanis International in Vienna, Austria, on July 6, 1983.

President Irby was first elected to the International Board of Trustees, the 18-man governing body of Kiwanis in 1971. He served two years as a Trustee, left the Board, and returned to serve a second two-year term as Trustee, a one year term as Vice-President, a one-year term as Treasurer, and a one-year term as President - Elect. He is the Chairman of the Executive of Committee of the Board.

Before his election to the International Board, Irby served as President of the Kiwanis Club of Tyler, Lt. Governor and Governor of the Texas-Oklahoma Kiwanis District, and as both member and Chairman of the Kiwanis International Committees on Major Emphasis Program and New Club Building. He is a Life Fellow of the Kiwanis International Foundation and hold Life Member Status in Kiwanis International. Aubrey has been a Kiwanian for 24 years.

Also active in professional civic affairs in addition to Kiwanis, Irby is a past member of the Texas Association of Broadcasters and of the National Association of Broadcasters. He served as Vice-President of the Tyler Area Chamber of Commerce and a member of the Tyler Board of Equalization. He is a Past President and Life Member of the Tyler Junior Chamber of Commerce; a member of Tyler Masonic Lodge 1233, and a charter member of Sharon Temple A.A.O.N.M.S.

In addition, Irby served as Vice President and Past President of the East Texas Area Council, Boy Scouts of America; a board member and Past President of the YMCA; board member, South Central Region, BSA; board member, East Texas Fair Association; Past President, United Fund Annual Campaign; YMCA annual membership chairman; Past President, East Texas Lighthouse for the Blind; ETAC, BSA membership chairman, Young Life Annual Finance campaign and Council for Retarded Children finance campaign; past board member, Smith County Chapter, American Red Cross; East Texas Hospital Foundation Board and Texas Association of United Funds, Smith County Heart Association and East Texas Baptist College; member, First Baptist Church of Tyler. Aubrey is holder of the Silver Beaver Award, BSA; and the Outstanding Jaycee Award.

Aubrey and his wife Margaret, have two sons, a daughter, and five grandchildren.
