Mike was born in Plymouth, Michigan. He served in the U.S. Army for two years. He graduated from General Motors Institute in 1958 with a Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering. He was employed by General Motors Corporation at the Proving Grounds in Milford, Michigan from January, 1953 until his retirement in July, 1983.

Mike joined the Kiwanis Club of Howell in October of 1958 and will have 25 years of perfect attendance this year. He is a three time past President of his club. He served his club as Secretary for 5 years. He is a Past Lt. Governor of Division 10, a Past District Chairman of Alcohol and Drug Abuse (ODA) for 2 years, a Past District Chairman of Sports for 5 years, and Past District Chairman of Citizenship Services for 1 year. He was elected Trustee of the Kiwanis of Michigan Foundation, for Division 10, in 1977 and is in his third, three year term as trustee. This year (1983-84) he is serving as the President of the Kiwanis of Michigan Foundation.

Mike's community involvement goes far beyond his Kiwanis activities, with the Oak Grove Methodist Church, where he is Past President of the Men's Club. He also served as Sunday School Assistant Principal and a member of the Board of Trustees.

He served the Howell area United Way as a member of the board for four years, serving his last year as their President. He worked on the fund raising for the McPherson Community Health Center and the Howell Recreation Center as the representative for the Howell Kiwanis Club. Mike also served as Vice Chairman of the Sustaining membership Enrollment Program for the Mulhauke District of the Wolverine Council of the Boy Scouts of America.
