A contribution of \$1,000 was made to the Kiwanis Children's Fund for Kiwanis' world wide goal of eliminating iodine deficiency.

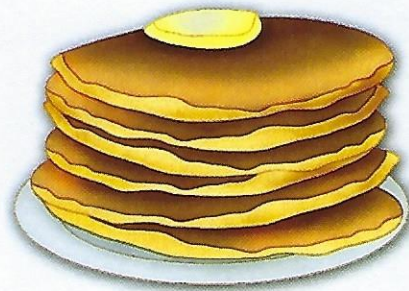
As Human and Spiritual Values Chairperson, Mike, has championed many programs:
