BIKE SAFETY RODEO 40 Kids Provided Free Helmets

On May 7, the Kiwanis Club of Weymouth held its first annual Bike Safety Rodeo at South Shore Christian Academy with assistance from the Weymouth Police, the Bicycle Link, and Tufts Library. With a grant from the Kiwanis Foundation of New England, Kiwanis provided more than 40 children with a free bicycle helmet expertly fitted by WPD Sgt. Jen Pompeo. In addition, the Bicycle Link generously did a safety inspection for each kid's bicycle before they completed a safety-focused obstacle course. Tufts Library graciously leant us

folding tables and use of their bathrooms. They also prepared a bicycle-themed craft in the Children's Room, where many of our helmeted youngsters went after the Rodeo.

The day turned out to be unseasonably cold, causing our volunteers to hold hot chocolate and do jumping jacks to stay warm throughout the day. 
Membership Committee - The Membership Committee focuses on recruiting new members to join Kiwanis. This is vital role because more hands means more service!
