11. Make sure to be at the Centennial Celebration on Wednesday November 6.

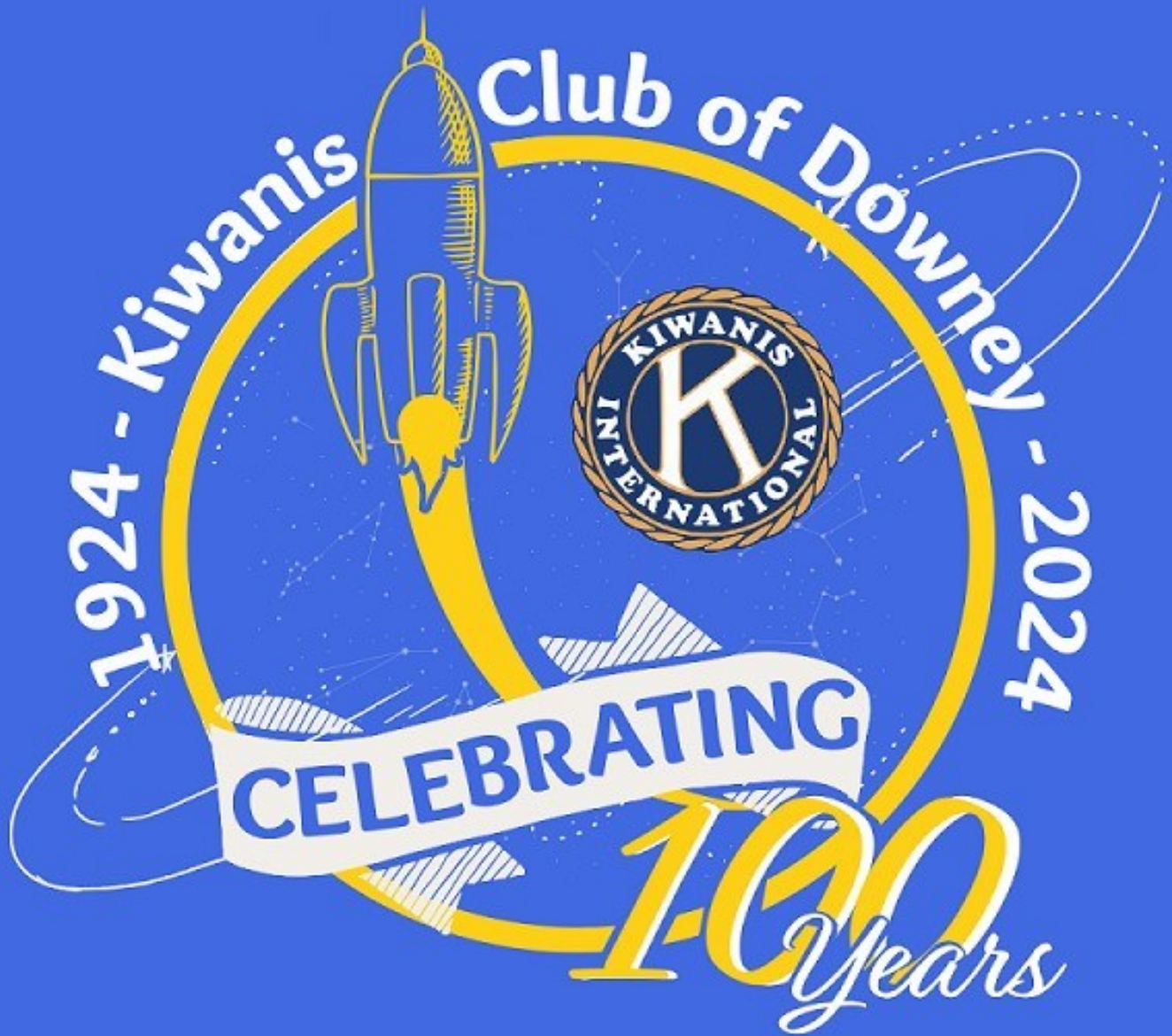
