The six permanent Objects of Kiwanis International were approved by Kiwanis Club delegates at the 1924 Convention in Denver, Colorado. Through the succeeding decades they have remained unchanged.

To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life.

To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.

To promote the adoption and the application of higher social, business, and professional standards.

To develop by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive and serviceable citizenship.

To provide through Kiwanis Clubs, a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service and to build better communities.

To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism and good will.

Notes from Treasurer Leslie Jones

"Kids Need Kiwanis" is a slogan from the Kiwanis International (KI) global awareness campaign. One way Kids Need Kiwanis is through Service Leadership Programs (SLP). There are five SLP in Kiwanis:

- K-Kids Club elementary school
- Builders Club- middle school
- Key Club and KIWINS
- high school
- Circle K college/ university
- Aktion- adults with disabilities

The primary focus of SLP is to prepare students to be the most engaged members of their communities through service leadership. Research has shown that students who volunteer tend to get higher grades, feel connected to the larger community, develop leadership abilities and have improved social and emotional health.

Our Downey Kiwanis Club currently sponsors 2 Builders Clubs (St. Raymond and Griffiths Middle School), 2 Key Clubs (Downey & Lakewood High Schools), and 1 KI-WINS Club (Downey High School). Each club has a school faculty advisor and a Kiwanis advisor. Each club is student-



led and determines its own schedule, service projects, and other activities.

Advisors play an important part in the success of the club. They are directly involved in student growth. They serve as mentors & coaches, helping students develop skills and empowering them to become independent leaders. Advisors give feedback on the club's ideas for fundraising and service projects. They ensure service remains the focus as the purpose of the club. Advisors can introduce the club to community charities or cause-related organizations that they might not have discovered on their own and make sure the club's choices for projects and service initiatives are student-led. Through service projects, leadership roles, and team efforts, students learn what it means to follow

through, speak honestly, and treat others with respect. As advisors work with students, they develop relationships. SLP and Kiwanis Advisors help students invest in the future of a community and discover their heart to serve.

For many adults, the decision to be a Kiwanis Advisor is one of the most rewarding activities in their Kiwanis life. They may not feel it immediately, but as years go by, memories of the activities and the students, and in some cases, the notes and phone calls from the students who express their gratitude for their commitment and guidance, is priceless.




