Sarah Josepha Hale - The Author of the Children's Poem "Mary Had a Little Lamb" originally known as Mary's Lamb" - was persistent in arguing for the National Holiday of "Thanksgiving" with President Abraham Lincoln in 1830 - Secretary of State William Seward wrote the Thanksgiving Proclamation & President Abraham Lincoln Issued it, however Sarah is credited with making it happen!
