The **2022-2023** Distinguished Club Award Program

To automatically qualify to be a **2022-2023** Distinguished Club, your club must achieve **Criteria No. 1 & No.2.**

No. 1 Sponsor or Co-Sponsor a new Kiwanis Club during the **2022-2023** Kiwanis Year.

No. 2 Have a net increase in membership of 3 members for **2022-2023.**

OR, if your Club does not automatically qualify, you can still be a 2022-2023 Distinguished Club by achieving item No.1 or No. 2 AND at least 8 of the following 9 criteria – No. 3 - 11.

No. 3 The **2022-2023** Club President shall participate in Club Leadership Education (Either at a Divisional or Regional Event.)

No. 4 The **2022-2023** Club Secretary shall participate in Secretary Training (Either at a Regional Training Session, or using the On-Line Training.)

No. 5 The club shall be represented by Inter-Club values at the **2022-2023** Mid-Winter Regionals and at the **2022-2023** District Convention in Lafayette, LA (Clubs with 20 or fewer members need a minimum of two members in attendance, clubs with 21-30 members need three members, and clubs with 31 or more members need at least four members in attendance).

No. 6 The club shall provide at least two (2) service projects or programs for children in the community.

No. 7 Actively participate in a Kiwanis One Day Project.

No. 8 The club shall pay the International Dues and the District Dues by **November 30, 2022.**

No. 9 The club shall make a contribution to the Annual Club Giving Program of the Kiwanis Children's Fund in the amount of at least \$6 per member and to the La.-Miss.-W.Tenn. Kiwanis District Foundation in the amount of \$6 per member or \$100 – whichever is greater.

No. 10 The club shall submit the Report of the Election of **2023-2024** Club Officers by **June 1, 2023** on the Kiwanis International Website PortalBuzz.

No. 11 The club shall Charter a new K-Kids club at a local school.
