At the last Key Club District Convention, the delegates voted to increase District dues **from \$6.50 to \$7.00/year**. **International dues will be \$10.00 a year this year**. A \$3.00 increase was approved by the delegates at the International Convention. As a result the <u>total dues</u> that need to be sent in will be <u>**\$17.00 per student**</u>.

Early dues deadline: November 1. For payments received by November 1, your club will earn an early-bird patch.

Dues deadline: December 1.

After the following February 1, any club that hasn't paid will be considered <u>suspended.</u>


