YOU MUST LIST ALL PARTICIPANTS ON THE BACK OF THIS FORM

A signed waiver is required for every parade participant. Children under 18 must have a parent or guardian sign for them.

Rules & Information

- 1) Registration is from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. Judging begins at 9 a.m. Entries not in their assigned place by 9 a.m. may not be judged. The parade begins promptly at 10 a.m. Registration is free.
- 2) Responsible adult must sign a Kiwanis waiver for each entrant in their group. List all children on the back of the form, and provide waiver signatures for each child.
- 3) **Participants ribbons must be worn by all participants 18 and under.** Kiwanis provides the ribbons during registration. Each participating child and accompanying adults will also receive a ticket for **free admission to the fair, good any day of the fair, UNTIL WE RUN OUT.**
- 4) Animals must be on leash, harness, or halter with reins. Parade entrant must clean up any waste material.
- 5) No go-karts, motorbikes, mini-motorbikes, ATVs, or lawn mowers.
- 6) **HELMETS ARE REQUIRED** when riding bikes, trikes, rollerblades, skateboards, scooters, unicycles, etc.
- 7) **DO NOT THROW CANDY.** Participants may **hand out** candy along the sides of the parade route but may not throw candy where children might run in front of the line of march. **"SAFETY FIRST."**
- 8) **NO CAMPAIGNING.** Current officeholders may participate as representatives of their governmental office, but may not display campaign materials, literature, or handouts.
